For Children Age 6 Weeks—15 months

The primary daily goal of our infant program is to provide a stimulating, safe and nurturing learning environment.

We focus on transitioning, socialization, play, communication, overall development, and making friends. Daily experiences include age appropriate activities that promote curiosity and socialization supporting each developmental stage. Playtime and other daily experiences help boost cognitive, language, fine and gross motor skills as well as build self-esteem.

We lay the groundwork for trusting relationships, building continuity between school and home. Our dedicated staff of teachers communicate with the children using verbal and non-verbal gestures. We read books, tell stories, and sing songs to model conversation skills. Using picture books, puzzles and games children build connections with sounds, objects and words.

Children discover the world through play in our bright and inviting classrooms. We use a variety of materials in different colors, sizes, textures and shapes encouraging individuality and self-expression. We support and encourage physical development with age appropriate equipment as children move from being cuddled and carried all the way to crawling, running, and climbing. Exploration, self-discovery, and imagination is promoted through arts & crafts, music, movement and many other school activities.

Over the school year, children bloom, blossom and grow acquiring skills for the educational journey ahead.
